



SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM GENERAL GUIDELINES

Program Goals

To encourage a deserving and talented high school senior in Cape May County in the pursuit of artistic training at an accredited art school.

Eligibility

1. The candidate must be a full time resident of Cape May County who has received acceptance at an accredited art school.
2. Proof of acceptance by educational institution is required.

Process

1. The complete application package must be submitted/post dated no later than April 24, 2009. **No late or incomplete applications will be considered.**
2. Three letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application: (1) attesting to the character; and (2) from art professionals or teachers.
3. Submit **(2) short, typed narratives**:
 - 1) Please describe your career choice and reasons for this choice.
 - 2) Why do you deserve to be awarded a scholarship from the Cape May County Art League? Tell us about yourself, give specifics. Possibilities include (but are not limited to): extra curricular activities, awards, sports, clubs, job, volunteer work, academic achievement. Be sure to include anything specifically related to the Arts

Scholarship Award

The scholarship award in the amount of \$500 will be paid directly to the recipient's college or university upon the presentation to the Cape May County Art League a tuition bill and proof of a 'B' average or better for the first semester.
